LOAN APPROVED!

ON SEPTEMBER 28, 1981, AT APPROXIMATELY 4:45 P.M., ALL THE PRAYERS, HARD WORK AND LONG MONTHS OF WAITING BEGAN TO TAKE FORM AS THE FINAL PAPERS WERE SIGNED AND THE HUD LOAN FOR FIVE MILLION, SEVENTY-SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS WAS APPROVED IN LOUISVILLE, KENTUCKY, AT THE OFFICE OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT. PRESENT FOR THE CEREMONIES OF THE DAY, REPRESENTING CBO WERE WALLY RENDEL, PRESIDENT; JOSEPH HAGER, VICE PRESIDENT; LARRY BRANDON, SECRETARY; SHERRIELL E. STOREY, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR; BRAD DENNIS, ATTORNEY.

DON ESTES, OF RAY BELL CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, BRENTWOOD, TENNESSEE, REPRESENTED RAY BELL. MR. ESTES HAS ASSURED US THAT EARTH MOVING EQUIPMENT WILL BE ON THE SITE OCTOBER 5, 1981, OR BEFORE, TO BEGIN THE SITE WORK. THE CONSTRUCTION TIME HAS BEEN SET AT EIGHTEEN MONTHS.
