Where will my seat be?

1. *Sponsors and Guests of Sponsors, Row Hosts, and our Hall of Honored Servant 2025 Inductee Guests, Row Hosts, and Special Guests will be seated in **Sections B & C***
2. *All other attendees are General Seating and may choose their seat.*
3. ***There are no bad seats in the auditorium** and there is a large screen that will show our speakers at larger-than-life size.*

Will a physical ticket be mailed to me?

No, if you have received this email, you have registered for the event, which allows us to plan for total seating. No additional documentation is needed at the door that evening for proof of entry.

What time do the doors open?

Exterior doors open at 5:15 PM and seating begins at 5:30 PM in Theater 81. The Ol' Elkhorn Pickers Club will be performing from 5:30 - 6 PM to entertain you if you prefer to get to your seat early, or feel free to mix and mingle in the lobby. The program begins at 6 PM.

Will there be food at the event?

The event does not include table seating. It is floor seating to be as efficient as possible with the space. As such, there will be no food served at the 'Playing with a Greater Purpose' event, as the purpose is to raise funds to expand our older adult ministry.
